

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Sealed proposals marked for “LUC – STARR AVENUE IMPROVEMENTS” will be received by the City of Oregon, Ohio, at the Office of the Director of Public Service at the Oregon Municipal Building, 5330 Seaman Road, Oregon, Ohio 43616-2608, until 10:00 A.M., local time, on Thursday, May 14, 2020, and then opened and read aloud.

The proposed work consists of resurfacing 1.59 miles of Starr Avenue from S. Whittlesey Avenue to S. Lallendorf Road. The project will also include ADA curb ramp upgrades and striping.

Bidding Documents may be examined on the City of Oregon Bidding Information web page www.oregonohio.org/engineering/engineering/bidding-information.html. All bids must be made on the proposal forms, which with the contract documents, including Specifications and Bid Forms must be obtained from Newfax Corporation, Inc., 333 West Woodruff Ave., Toledo, OH 43604, Phone (419) 241-5157, Fax (419) 241-2018, Monday through Friday, 8:30 am to 4:30 pm. Contact Newfax Corporation for cost of documents. Deposits are non-refundable.

Each bid must be accompanied by either a bid bond in an amount of 10% of the bid amount with a surety satisfactory to the City or by certified check, cashier’s check, or letter of credit upon a solvent bank in the amount of not less than 10% of the bid amount in favor of the City of Oregon.

Bid bonds shall be accompanied by Proof of Authority of the official or agent signing the bond. A Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond properly executed can be submitted in lieu of a bid bond or check.

Attention of bidders is called to all of the requirements contained in this bid packet, particularly to the Federal Labor Provisions and Davis-Bacon Wages, various insurance requirements, various equal opportunity provisions; and the requirements for a performance bond or a bid guaranty and contract bond for 100% of the contract price.

This project is classified as a Local Public Agency project with the City of Oregon Administering the project and the Ohio Department of Transportation providing project oversight. Only ODOT pre-qualified contractors are eligible to submit bids for this project.

This project is being funded with and Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) grant.

At least 7 percent of this contract as bid shall be subcontracted to DBE (Disadvantaged Business Enterprises) who have been certified as DBEs by the Ohio Department of Transportation.

No bidder may withdraw his bid within sixty (60) days after the actual date of the opening thereof. The Council of the City of Oregon, OH, reserves the right to waive any informalities or to reject any or all bids.

The estimate for the base bid cost of construction is \$1,075,000.
