

SIMPLE SITE PLAN --- RESIDENTIAL ---

SHOW ANY AND ALL STRUCTURES AS NECESSARY TO ACCURATELY SHOW Your Property. This SITE PLAN should show what you want to do and may not necessarily be to code. That is the reason for SITE PLAN REVIEW by the Inspection Dept Staff.

INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1: On a sheet of paper draw your lot to show what exists.

Step 2: Show Existing Buildings

Step 3: Fill in dimensions.

Dimensions are taken to property lines or to the centerline of the street.

Step 4: Add new buildings, pools, additions or sheds as necessary.

Step 5: Show distances between new buildings, pools, additions or sheds as they exist or as they are proposed.

Most plans can be done on 8-1/2 x 11 paper. Graph paper is best as no ruler is really necessary.
