

**NOTICE TO BIDDERS**  
Ordinance No. 1-2023

Sealed proposals marked for “***WATERLINE REPLACEMENT PROGRAM - SEAMAN ROAD, NORDEN ROAD, AND WYNN ROAD***” will be received by the City of Oregon, Ohio, at the Office of the Director of Public Service at the Oregon Municipal Building, 5330 Seaman Road, Oregon, Ohio 43616, until 2:00 P.M., local time, on Wednesday, September 20, 2023, and immediately thereafter publicly opened and read aloud.

The scope of work includes, but is not limited to, the replacement of 16,000 LF of 8” waterline on Seaman Road, the replacement of 4,600 LF of 8” waterline on Wynn Road, the installation of 3,000 LF of 8” waterline on Norden Road, the replacement of 2,000 LF of 8” waterline on Norden Road also including the replacement of service connections, fire hydrants, valves, and all necessary appurtenances to complete this improvement.

Bidding Documents may be examined during normal office hours at the office of the Director of Public Service, 5330 Seaman Road, Oregon, OH 43616. All bids must be made on the proposal forms, which with the contract documents, including Specifications and Bid Forms must be obtained from Newfax Corporation, Inc., 333 West Woodruff Avenue, Toledo, OH 43604, Phone (419) 241-5157, Fax (419) 241-2018, Monday through Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Contact Newfax Corporation for cost of documents. Deposits are non-refundable.

Each bidder is required to furnish with its proposal, a Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond in an amount of 10% of the bid amount in accordance with Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code and the Information To Bidders. Bid security furnished in Bond form, shall be satisfactory to the City and be issued by a Surety Company or Corporation licensed in the State of Ohio to provide said surety.

Each Proposal must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the proposal and all persons interested therein. Each bidder must submit evidence of its experiences on projects of similar size and complexity.

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the projects will, to the extent practicable use Ohio products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of their project. Additionally, contractor compliance with the equal employment opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123, the Governor’s executive Order of 1972, and Governor’s Executive order 84-9 shall be required.


Bidders must comply with the Davis-Bacon wage rates on public improvements in Lucas County and the City of Oregon, Ohio as determined by the federal government.

This procurement is subject to the EPA policy of encouraging the participation of small businesses in rural areas (SBRAs).

No bidder may withdraw his bid within 90 days after the actual date of the opening thereof. The Council of the City of Oregon, Ohio, reserves the right to waive any informalities or to reject any or all bids.

The Engineer’s estimated cost of construction for the Bid is \$3,291,000. This project is being partially funded with Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) funds and with Ohio EPA Water Supply Revolving Loan Account (WSRLA) funds with Buy American requirements.
